TOLL INCREASE FOR DULLES GREENWAY

Effective July 1, 2010, the maximum base toll for travel on the Dulles Greenway will increase \$0.30 to \$3.70 as permitted by the State Corporation Commission's (SCC) approved toll structure. The congestion toll will increase by fifty cents, to \$4.50.

The schedule of new toll rates for 2-axle vehicles is noted below:

It should be noted that those Greenway motorists traveling onto or from the Dulles Toll Road will continue to pay the applicable Dulles Toll Road toll currently \$0.75 for a 2 axle vehicle; bringing the total collected to \$4.45 and \$5.25 respectively.
